have been designed to recognize programs, individuals, and innovations that have made outstanding contributions to enhance the outdoor advertising control program.

WHAT are the NAHBA Awards of Excellence?

This will be an annual awards program developed by NAHBA to honor programs that excel in the outdoor advertising control program.

WHO is eligible to enter?

Nominations will be accepted from any party that is an active member of NAHBA.

WHO will judge the entries:

The *NAHBA Board of Directors* will select four (4) individuals from various backgrounds and states to serve as the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee will serve for a one-year term.

WHEN are entries due?

WHAT should you remember while preparing an entry?

1. Entries should fall into at least one of the three categories. (1) Innovations, (2) Streamlining and Integration and (3) Chairman's Award. Please indicate which category(s) your entry will address.
2. Entries for the Innovations and/or Streamlining and Integration Awards should address as many of the listed criteria as possible in their category.
3. Entry must include a **completed application** form and a summary of the accomplishments of the nominated project, process, person, or group. Summaries may not exceed two (2) letter-size pages, utilizing a font size no smaller than 12 points.
4. Entries should include at least two professional quality color prints (JPEG) showing the associated project or person(s) nominated. The photos should be clearly labeled and identified with the entry name and description of the view shown. Please submit high quality images.
5. Entries may be submitted in multiple categories.
6. All materials submitted become the property of NAHBA and may be used by NAHBA for its purposes. No entry materials will be returned.
